Testing the EquityTool's Ability to Assess Eligibility for Container-Based Sanitation Subsidies in Cap Haitien, Haiti Project

The *Testing the EquityTool's Ability to Assess Eligibility for Container-Based Sanitation Subsidies in Cap Haitien, Haiti* project, implemented by Sustainable Organic Integrated Livelihoods (SOIL), was conducted in a subset of SOIL's existing customers based in Cap Haitien, Haiti, to both determine the suitability of EquityTool wealth assessment to SOIL's container-based sanitation (CBS) services, and also to help SOIL better understand the impact of clients' wealth status on their ability to pay for services. The [EquityTool](#) was found to be well suited to the CBS project context.

The learnings from the study have been used to support rapid expansion of CBS service coverage, and in January 2025, SOIL will begin targeted subsidies for those with lower ability to pay. The EquityTool is now an integral tool in the CBS service, and is also being explored for broader use by the Haitian Ministry of Water and Sanitation and the Ministry of Public Health.
